With the assistance of the parishioners from St Rose of Lima and St John the Evangelist, the **St Rose SVDP Conference** continued its efforts to serve the poor and needy during the ongoing pandemic. The pandemic has only intensified the loneliness and isolation among many of our seniors, the plight of the homeless in our community, the stress on new or expectant moms, and single parents.

The Conference helped make living through this tough time a little bit easier for these groups of individuals and families by supplying Care Packages. These packages contained useful items such as toiletries, blankets, gloves, hats, jig saw puzzles, scented candles, healthy snacks, diapers, baby wipes, parenting books, coffee mugs, bath bombs, activity books, etc.

Each donor was asked to include items to help boost the mental health of the recipient, such as a handwritten note of encouragement, a rosary, prayer card, gift card, etc.

The members of the St Rose SVDP Conference would like to take this time to thank all our donors who make our programs possible and the lives of the needy a bit easier.
